Must be 21 years or older +
Accepting submissions in traditional media & computer graphics + Entry must be completely original concept not used in other posters or promotions + No fluorescent or metallic colors + One artist per entry; no collaborations + Entries cannot be subsequently sold by artist with any SACC identification incorporated in the artwork + Judges will consider concept, imagery, visual presentation & merchandising adaptation + SACC reserves the right to ask winning artist for changes to the artwork before poster is printed + SACC is not responsible for loss or damage to entries + SACC will retain ownership & full copyright of the winning poster & its reproductions + SACC may adapt elements of the poster for other official SACC merchandise + SACC will retain ownership of the original poster artwork & may reproduce, in whole or in part, the artwork with no additional consideration to the artist + Any use or adaptation of the artwork is within the sole discretion of SACC
